



Jasper County Tuition Assistance Program

- Tuition Assistance Program begins with the high school graduating class of 2010
- Program begins Fall semester 2010
- Any student living in Jasper county, even if attending a school outside the county, qualifies
- Private school and home school graduates residing in Jasper county do qualify
- Any student graduating in December 2009 but walking in May 2010 does qualify
- Graduates of Jasper County Schools living in other counties do not qualify
- Jasper County GED option program graduates do not qualify
- Students that qualify must apply for tuition assistance and FAFSA by May 1, begin college Fall semester following high school graduation, maintain 2.5 GPA, and be full-time status
- Scholarship is permanently lost if student fails to maintain a full-time status or 2.5 GPA
- Scholarship covers tuition/fees charged to students (REG, TECH, HEALTH)
- Book, dorm, parking, schedule change, lab, or club fees are not covered
- Tuition does not cover summer semesters
