The subject property is located immediately to the east and on the east side of the road at the junction of CR 20 and CR 206, within an unincorporated portion of northern Jasper County, approximately 2 miles east of Montrose and 8 miles south of the Jasper/Newton County line in Section 5, Township 3 North, Range 11 East, Jasper County. The land is comprised of 0.4 acres. A 900 Square Foot, metal frame, metal clad building, that has been used for public related services is on the property. The Tax Assessor's office states that the building was built in 2009. It is situated on a concrete slab and is insulated. The interior of the building features an open-door plan that includes a functioning kitchen and a single restroom.
